Stephen Fandrich has been a resident performing artist of Seattle for more than 35 years. He is a composer and pianist, an “otherworldly musical genius.” His piano improvisations exude a rare and rich combination of influences as diverse as classical and jazz piano and Indonesian gamelan, but are uniquely his own. You don’t know what you’re going to get when he sits down at the piano, but it will be profound.

Stephen gave an unforgettable performance at The Point in 2022. People who had the good fortune to be present commented:

- “There’s no pianist like Stephen anywhere. No one approaches the piano like he does.”

Also to be noted, not every seat will have a view of the pianist, but the sound will fill all space.
